



Cutting Nylon Strap Instruction for Stride / Stride Dual

- ❖ **Pls note:** In a case of returning the unit for a refund, there will be a charge of \$4.99 per strap deduction if it is cut.
- ❖ Proper fitment of the collar is important to the comfort of your dog during training.
- ❖ A collar worn for too long or made too tight on your dog's neck may cause skin irritations ranging from redness to skin sores.
- ❖ Avoid leaving Collar on your dog for more than 12 hours per day.
- ❖ If possible reposition the receiver collar on your dog's neck every one to two hours.
- ❖ Check the fitment of the Collar to prevent excessive pressure on your dog.
- ❖ When using a separate collar, do not cover and put pressure on the Collar.
- ❖ Wash your dog's neck area and the contacts of the receiver unit weekly with a damp cloth.
- ❖ Examine your dog's neck area daily for signs of a rash or sores.
- ❖ Should a rash or sore develops on your dog discontinue use of the collar until the skin has healed.
- ❖ If the condition persists beyond 48 hours, please consult your veterinarian for treatment.

Important:

Remove the collar from the dog's neck before you attempt to cut the extra strap off.

STEP 1.

Look for the cutting point.



STEP 2.

Cut either one of these two straps, above the stitching area with a box and an X inside.



STEP 3

After cutting the strap, this is how it should look like.



STEP 4

Remove the clips.



STEP 5

Put the Receiver, and then put the clips back on the strap.



STEP 6

Put the collar around the dog's neck (with the receiver at dog's neck).

STEP 7

Snap the end clips together and adjust the collar to the length you desire.

Pls note : There should be a finger space between the collar and your dog's neck.
